

From the desk of DDD:

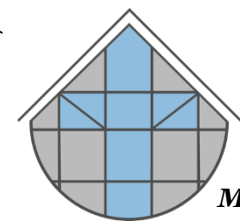
These last few weeks I have shared about the need for revival and examples and how to prepare for revival. Let me summarize a few basics as we gather for a series of preaching meeting with Dr. Bob Pitman.

1. Pray for a special anointing on each service and on Bro. Bob.
2. Personally prepare:
 - a. Pray for personal revival in your life
 - b. Confess and turn from any known sin in your life
 - c. Commit to attend every service if not legitimately hindered
 - d. Invite anyone you know who may not be a Christian or church attender to come
3. Remember, God's Promise to those who are God's children:

Matthew 7:7-8 "Ask, and it will be given to you; seek, and you will find; knock, and it will be opened to you. For everyone who asks receives, and he who seeks finds, and to him who knocks it will be opened".

Remember to pray Psalm 85:6, "Wilt thou not revive us again that thy people may rejoice in thee".

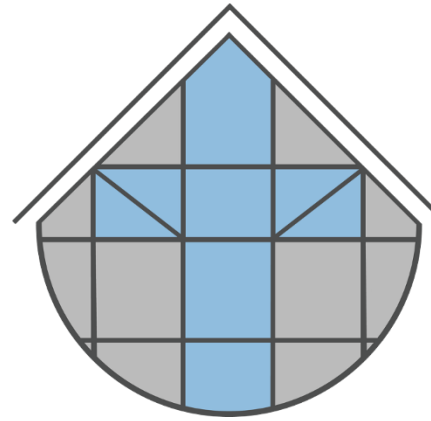

Church Family,
Next week our church will come together for special days that we simply call **Revival**. The word itself carries a wonderful meaning. Revival means *life again*. It speaks of something that has grown quiet, dull, or weary suddenly coming alive once again.

But revival is not something that can be manufactured. We can schedule services. We can invite a preacher. We can announce the meetings and prepare the music. Yet real revival doesn't begin on a church calendar. It begins in the hearts of God's people.

Throughout Scripture, whenever revival came, it followed a familiar pattern. God's people humbled themselves. They examined their hearts. They confessed their sins. And they turned again toward the Lord.

David showed this in Psalm 51:10-12: *"Create in me a clean heart, O God, And renew a steadfast spirit within me. Do not cast me away from Your presence, And do not take Your Holy Spirit from me. Restore to me the joy of Your salvation, And uphold me by Your generous Spirit."*

Those words were not written during a spiritual high point in David's life. They came after one of the darkest failures he ever experienced. Yet from that broken place David prayed for something deeper than relief, he prayed for renewal. That is what revival is. Revival is not merely emotional excitement. Revival is not just a series of good church services. Revival is when God renews the hearts of His people.

As we approach these upcoming revival services, the most important preparation is not found in the schedule or the program. The most important preparation is spiritual.

This week would be a good time for each of us to:

- Pray. Ask God to move in our church and in our own lives.
- Examine our hearts. Is there anything the Lord wants to correct?
- Confess sin. Nothing blocks revival like unconfessed sin.
- Come expectantly. God often meets those who come hungry for Him.

We are praying that these days will be more than meetings on the calendar. We are praying that God will do something eternal in our church family.

Make it a priority to be here and see what God will do in your life and family.

"Will You not revive us again, That Your people may rejoice in You?" — Psalm 85:6
