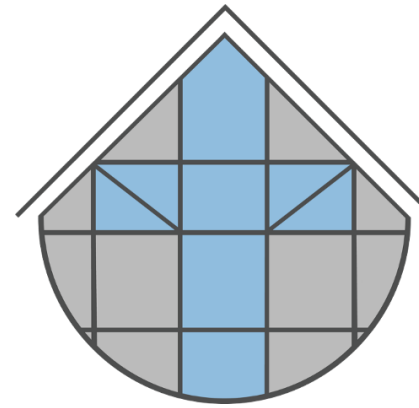

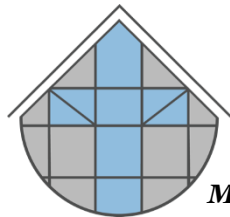

Wednesday, Sept. 23, before the school day begins, approximately one million middle & high school students will gather around their school flagpoles to pray. They will pray for their classmates, families, schools, communities, and for a spiritual awakening across our nation. This year's theme verse is Matthew 11:28: **"Come to me, all who are weary and burdened, and I will give you rest."**

As a "semi-old" student pastor who has been in this game for a while, I can say without hesitation that I believe this generation of students is carrying more than we often realize. They are tired. They are burdened. And they desperately need the kind of rest and hope that only Jesus can give.

The world many of us grew up in certainly had its challenges. We had bad days at school. We dealt with bullies. We embarrassed ourselves. We made mistakes. Most of the time, when we went home, we could leave those things behind. Our students don't always have that luxury. Because of the phones in their pockets, the pressure can follow them everywhere. The comments, comparisons, drama, expectations, and negativity don't necessarily stop when the school bell rings. There is little opportunity to simply get away from it all. But church family, we have an incredible opportunity to use those same phones—and more importantly, our own words and actions—for something good. If our students can receive discouragement so easily, then we can make sure they receive encouragement just as easily.

As your student pastor, I'm asking you to join me in doing three simple things:

1. Pray for our students. Pray for them by name. Pray for their faith, friendships, decisions, families, and the pressures they face every day.

2. Encourage them personally. Send them a text or a message. Tell them you're proud of them—not just when they score a touchdown, make a great play, earn an award, or accomplish something big. Tell them you're proud of who they are becoming. Let them know they are seen, valued, and loved.

3. Speak to them when you see them. Whether they are an SFBC student or simply a young person you cross paths with, take a moment to say hello. Ask how they're doing. Tell them you're glad to see them. Remind them that they matter.

These may seem like small things to us, but they may be exactly what a student needs that day. Jesus said, **"Come to me, all who are weary and burdened, and I will give you rest."** As the church, we have the privilege of pointing this generation toward Him while also reminding them that they do not have to carry their burdens alone.

Let's be a church that prays for our students, encourages them, knows them, and makes sure they never have to wonder whether their church family cares about them.
